CONSENT AGENDA

A motion was made by Commissioner Shumate, duly seconded by Commissioner Watson, and all members voting affirmatively and so carried to approve the consent agenda presented as read by Chairman Hutcheson. The consent agenda includes the minutes from the January 11, 2023 meeting, and the claims docket for January 10, 2023 – January 23, 2023 for \$1,133,292.36.

DISTRICT 2 – APPROVE RELOCATING THE TORNADO SIREN AT 431 AND BAKER’S CHAPEL ROAD INTERSECTION (600 FT); \$3,950.65 COUNTYWIDE

A motion was made by Commissioner Watson, duly seconded by Commissioner Baker, and all members voting affirmatively and so carried to approve relocating the tornado siren at 431 and Baker’s Chapel Road intersection (600 ft) for \$3,950.65 to be paid out of Countywide.

DISTRICT 4 – APPROVE NO ENGINE (JAKE BRAKES) SIGNS ON HUSTLEVILLE ROAD NEAR 4 WAY STOP, BOTH WAYS

A motion was made by Commissioner Baker, duly seconded by Commissioner Watson, and all members voting affirmatively and so carried to approve “No engine (jake brakes)” signs on Hustleville road near four-way stop, both ways. Roll call vote was done. Commissioner Shumate, yea, Commissioner Watson, yea, Commissioner Sims, nay, Commissioner Baker, yea. Motion passed with 3 yea’s and 1 nay.

ENGINEERING – APPROVE TO AWARD BID FOR THE CORONER’S NEW BUILDING

A motion was made by Commissioner Sims, duly seconded by Commissioner Baker, and all members voting affirmatively and so carried to approve to reject all bids for the Coroner Building and re-bid with new specs of a smaller facility.

JAIL – APPROVE TO INCREASE FUNDING FOR GENERATOR FROM ARPA CORONAVIRUS STATE AND LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY ACT FUNDS; \$80,000

A motion was made by Commissioner Sims, duly seconded by Commissioner Baker, and all members voting affirmatively and so carried to approve to increase funding for generator from ARPA Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Act funds in the amount of \$80,000.

SHERIFF – APPROVE ALLOWING THE PLACEMENT OF MONUMENT RECOGNIZING LAW ENFORCEMENT AT GUNTERSVILLE COURTHOUSE

A motion was made by Commissioner Sims, duly seconded by Commissioner Shumate, and all members voting affirmatively and so carried to approve the placement of a monument recognizing law enforcement at Gunterville Courthouse.

SHERIFF – APPROVE TO BID OUT FUEL CARDS
