RESOLUTION OF THE MARSHALL COUNTY COMMISSION
DESIGNATING TEMPORARY MEMBER OF THE
MARSHALL COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Alabama Code 40-3-4 (1975), the Chairman of the Marshall County Commission is vested with the authority to temporarily appoint members of the Marshall County Board of Equalization, in the event of a vacancy on the Board, for periods not to exceed forty-five (45) days; and

WHEREAS, at the request of the Marshall County Revenue Commissioner, there is a need for three temporary appointments to the Marshall County Board of Equalization.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Marshall County Commission appoints ROBERT MICHAEL HUNT, ELIZABETH MILLARD, and MICHAEL CLAY to the Marshall County Board of Equalization for a period of forty-five (45) days as specified by the Marshall County Revenue Commissioner, and for additional forty-five (45) day periods as the Marshall County Revenue Commissioner deems necessary to the complete the 2026 Board of Equalization Hearings.

APPROVE APPOINTING NOMINEE TO THE ALABAMA ASSOCIATION OF COUNTY COMMISSION (ACCA) LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE FY 2026-2027.
