SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS:

- (1) It is the bidder's responsibility to familiarize himself with and shall comply with all requirements and specifications as stated in the <u>Alabama Department of Transportation-Standard Specifications for Highway Construction-2022 Edition</u>. The definition for "State" as listed in the before mentioned manual, in Section 101.01, shall be changed to read as follows: "Marshall County, a political subdivision of the State of Alabama, the party of the first part to the contract acting by and through the Marshall County Engineer".
- (2) It shall be the bidder's responsibility to possess all proper County, State, and Federal licenses and shall familiarize himself with and shall comply with all Federal, State, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations.
- (3) Bids will be accepted based on the price index per gallon of asphalt as determined by the Alabama Department of Transportation for August of the year this bid is let. Any increase or decrease in asphalt prices will be determined and adjusted by the price index for the month of purchase.
- (4) The Contractor shall submit to the County, before paving operations begin, a job mix formula that meets the State specifications. The job mix formula shall be accompanied by a test report, certified by a professional engineer, or from an approved testing laboratory, showing these design criteria have been met. Also, to be submitted with the job mix formula is a letter from the testing laboratory or professional engineer certifying that the stockpiles from which the bituminous concrete is to be made have been inspected and are consistent with the samples used in the mix design and contain no foreign matter such as grass, mud, dirt or any other contaminants.
- (5) In selecting the plant from which the individual loads will be called for, the distance of haul from the plant to the job site will be considered in the cost.
- (6) The County may take random samples to confirm the mix is within the job mix formula and design criteria.
- (7) Material shall also conform to Section 410 "Bituminous Plant Mix Pavements-Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Highway Construction 2022 Edition." Lab test will be performed, as directed by the Marshall County Engineer, to determine compliance and the cost of such will be paid by the vendor.
- (8) The Marshall County Commission reserves the right to award this contract as a whole or in part, whichever is in the best interest of Marshall County.
- (9) Date of delivery shall be within five (5) working days of placement of each order.
- (10) This bid shall be good for the period beginning October 1, 2025, and going through September 30, 2026. However, an option to issue a second and third 12-month contract with the same pricing, terms and conditions is possible. The second or third contract, if agreed by both

parties, would begin the day after the first or second contract expires. Any successive contract must have the written approval by the County and the vendor.

- (11) Bids may be submitted either by mail or in person, however, Marshall County will not be responsible for the security of mailed bids. (Also, if mailing bid, please be advised that we do not receive mail before 10:00 A.M. daily, therefore mail early to ensure prompt arrival).
- (12) By signing and submitting of this bid, the vendor certifies that he/she is an equal opportunity employer.
- (13) Bidders <u>are required</u> to use this *Invitation for Bids*. Failure to do so will be cause for rejection of bid.
- (14) Bidders shall bid all items, sign, and return <u>all</u> sheets in the *Invitation for Bids* to <u>Marshall</u> <u>County Engineering Department</u>, 424 Blount Ave., Suite 305, Guntersville, AL 35976.
- (15) By signing this contract the contracting parties affirm, for the duration of the agreement that they will not violate federal immigration law or knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien within the State of Alabama. Furthermore, a contracting party found to be in violation of this provision shall be deemed in breach of the agreement and shall be responsible for all damages resulting therefrom.
- (16) Each individual bid must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the word "BID" and name of item marked on outside of envelope.
- (17) Please be advised that in the event a bid is received from a person, firm, or corporation deemed to be a responsible bidder, having a place of business within Marshall County, AL, and the bid is no more than five percent (5%) greater than the bid of the lowest responsible bidder, the Marshall County Commission may award the contract to the resident responsible bidder.

Each bidder is required to submit with the bid a certificate of E-Verify.

You are invited to bid on the above specifications. Any substitutes offered, other than the items specified, must include information showing that the substitute is of equal or better quality and equally or better suited for the purported use than the item specified. The right to reject any items or materials not of quality or under any provisions of this act is reserved.
